**5.2. QUALIFICATION AS ON THE DATE OF NOTIFICATION: 1. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:**

(a) Educational qualification for engagement of GDS is Secondary School Examination (SSE) pass certificate of 10th standard with passing marks in Mathematics and English conducted by any recognized Board of School Education by the Government of India/State Governments/ Union Territories in India. (b) The applicant should have studied the local language at least up to 10th Standard from a recognized board. The details of post-wise local language prescribed by the Department is given in Annexure-III. (c) Special Provisions in respect of knowledge of the local language for engagement of GDS in the state of Arunachal Pradesh, Goa and Sikkim: -

**i. Arunachal Pradesh:** - The Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh has declared 23 tribal languages/dialects spoken in the state as 'Third Language' vide their Notification No. SJETA-1601/10/2023 dated 09.02.2024. Therefore, the Department has made special provision for engagement of GDS in the State of Arunachal Pradesh, which will be applicable for five years from 01.03.2024, as under: Candidates applying for engagement as GDS in the offices situated in Arunachal Pradesh, should have the knowledge both, the languages, i.e. (i) 'English or Hindi' studied at least upto 10th standard and (ii) any of the tribal local languages/dialects, notified as third language from time to time by the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh. As these tribal local languages/dialects are not taught upto 10th Standard at present in schools, the proficiency of the same in the will be ascertained by the Department based on certificate to be issued by the concerned Deputy Commissioners or any other officer authorized by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh in this behalf, which will have to be produced by the shortlisted candidate at the time of physical verification of the documents. Failure to produce this document will entail cancellation of candidature. (Refer No. 17-11/2019-GDS dated 01.03.2024). **ii. Goa:** The Govt. of Goa vide their Notification No.4/19/2016/DOL/Cert.Kon/1249 dated 06.02.2025 has made knowledge of Konkani compulsory for appointment the Candidates applying for GDS posts in post offices located in Goa must have studied Konkani or Marathi at the 10th standard level. However, candidates who have studied only Marathi must also possess proficiency in Konkani. In cases where Konkani has not been studied up to the 10th standard, the candidate's proficiency shall be verified based on a certificate issued by Goa Konkani Akademi or any other Government/authorised authority, as nominated by the State of Goa for the purpose. (Refer No. 17-11/2019-GDS dated 07.10.2025)

**iii. Sikkim:** The Govt. of Sikkim has declared 19 tribal languages/dialects spoken in the state vide their Notification No. HOME/LAN-23/02/2024 dated 16.12.2025. The local language(s) for the purpose of engagement of GDS in the Post Offices/other offices of the Department situated in the State of Sikkim shall be as under:

"English and any one of the following 12 languages —Nepali, Bhutia, Lepcha, Limbu, Newari, Rai, Gurung, Mangar, Sherpa, Tamang, Sunuwar or Bhujel — studied at the 10th standard level. In cases where the candidate has not studied the aforesaid language(s) up to the 10th standard, proficiency in the concerned language shall be verified on the basis of a Certificate of Proficiency issued by the Joint Director (Languages & Text Book), Education Department, Government of Sikkim, or any other authority, duly notified by the Government of Sikkim in this behalf from time to time. (Refer No. 17-11/2019-GDS dated 05.01.2026)

**2. OTHER QUALIFICATIONS:** - i. Knowledge of computers. ii. Knowledge of cycling. iii. Adequate means of livelihood.

**6. RESERVATION:** (a) Candidates seeking reservation benefits available for SC/ ST/OBC/ PwBD/ EWS must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation as per the eligibility prescribed in this notification. They should also be in possession of a valid certificate in the prescribed format in support of their claim. **(b) Format of Certificates:** Applicants who wish to be considered for reserved vacancies or seek age relaxation, will have to produce the requisite certificate from the competent authority in the prescribed Format in Annexure-V at the time of physical verification of documents. In case of failure to produce the certificate in original, their candidature will be cancelled. In case of non-availability of caste certificate in the prescribed format, the shortlisted candidate, subject to verification of other documents, would be provisionally selected and would be required to submit the same within 15 days from the date of offer of provisional engagement. Failure in submitting the certificate during this period, her/his candidature will entail rejection of the candidate, and the post will be offered to the next available candidate in the subsequent lists to be issued by the Department. (c) There will be no relaxation in the upper age limit to EWS applicants. However, the persons belonging to EWS who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SC, ST and OBC shall get 10% reservation in engagement to the GDS posts. (d) A person seeking engagement on the basis of reservation to EWS must ensure that she/he is in possession of a valid Income Certificate in accordance with the guidelines of the Central Government given in the Department of Personnel and Training OM No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dated 31.01.2019. (e) A person seeking engagement on the basis of reservation of OBC/EWS may refer to the orders of DoPT/DoP mentioned para 6 of the Notification dated 12.07.2024, DoPT OM dated 25.07.2003 in the matter of crucial date in respect of OBC Certificate and clarification of the Staff Selection Commission dated 09.08.2024 in respect of EWS Certificate to decide the matter in individual cases. For the sake of clarity, it is informed that in respect of OBC, the candidate should not fall in the creamy layer as on the closing date of the of application irrespective of its date of issue. [Refer order No. 17-08/2017-GDS dated

09.10.2024] (f) In respect of EWS, the certificate of the relevant financial year is to be accepted if it is valid as on the last date of submission of the online application, irrespective of its date of issue. In both cases, the candidate should, however, be in possession of the valid certificate at the time of verification of documents even if it is issued after the closing date of receipt of applications. [Refer order No. 17-08/2017-GDS dated 09.10.2024] (g) Engagement of GDS will be subject to the instructions issued by the Department of Posts regarding the reservation of SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD categories. The applicants may go through the following instructions available on the official website of the Department: -

(h) Candidates with only benchmark physical disability will be considered as PwBD and entitled to age-relaxation/ reservation for Persons with Disabilities. Further, in case of a temporary disability certificate, the clarification issued by letter No. SC- 12/20/2025-RC-DOP Dated 22-12-2025 may be referred to, which inter alia provides as under: - (i) That the disability condition falling under the category "likely to improve" under the temporary disability category are not eligible for reservation. (ii) That the condition falling under other categories, i.e. progressive, nonprogressive or not likely to improve, are to be treated as eligible for reservation. (iii) The permissible disability for PwBD applicants is as under: -

\***Note 1** – Persons having disability in 'Both Leg (BL)' are eligible to apply for only on the posts of Dak Sevaks, which involve both delivery and stationery duties. Wherever candidates are selected in BL category for posts involving delivery duties, they will be transferred and posted on any other suitable non-delivery assignments having stationery duties.

\*\***Note 2** - Persons with Spinal Deformity and Spinal Injury (SD/SI) with any associated neurological/ limb dysfunction shall be covered under the respective subcategory, such as One Arm (OA), One leg (OL) for all categories of GDS and Both Leg (BL) in case of Dak sevak only as specified in Note 1 above.

**Examples of multiple disabilities'. i. Multiple disabilities under different categories:** An applicant with a benchmark disability under a different category, like low vision (LV) under category (a) & One Arm (OA) benchmark disability under category (c), will have to apply for the post under category (DE) only.

**ii. Multiple disabilities under the same categories:** An applicant with multiple benchmark disabilities under the same category, like One Arm (OA) and Acid Attack Victim benchmark disability under category (c), she/he will have to apply in the same category by selecting only one benchmark disability (in this instance, category (c) ) and not under category DE.

**7. HOW TO APPLY:** Applications are to be submitted in the online mode only at <https://indiapost.gov.in/gdsonlineengagement>. Applications received from any other mode shall not be entertained and no communication in this respect will be entertained/replied. Detailed instructions for registration, payment of fee, documents to be uploaded with the application, selection of posts etc. are given in Annexure-II.

**8. SELECTION CRITERIA:** (i) The applicants will be shortlisted for engagement on the basis of a system-generated merit list. (ii) The Merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained/ conversion of Grades/Points to marks (as explained in sub-paragraphs - iii to xiii below) in Secondary School Examination of 10th standard of recognised Boards aggregated to percentage to the accuracy of 4 decimals. (iii) For applicants where the Secondary School Examination of 10th standard mark sheet contains the "marks" as mentioned in each subject or "marks" and "Grade/Points" both, their "marks" will be worked out by taking into account the 'marks obtained'. In case any applicant applies with grades/points instead of marks, his/her application will be liable for cancellation. However, if for any particular subject (s) only grades are mentioned in the mark sheet, then for that subject (s) grades can be mentioned and the same need not to be converted to marks by the candidates. (iv) For applicants having only grades, subject-wise marks will be arrived for each subject, by applying the multiplying factor of 9.5 in the following manner:

(v) In case of the marks lists contain the Grades/Points, marks will be reckoned by taking the conversion of Grades and points with the multiplication factor (9.5) against the maximum points or grade as 100. (vi) Where Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is also provided, the marks will be arrived at by multiplying the CGPA by 9.5. Where individual grades in each subject as well as CGPA is given, the higher of the two marks will be taken. It is to clarify that the candidates are not required to convert their points/grades into "marks" and are required to mention the grades/points only (wherever applicable), while filling up the online application. The conversion of grades/ points to the marks would be carried out by the system before the declaration of results for the purpose of arriving at the merit. (vii) There are certain boards, like the Delhi Board of School Education (DBSE), which award both the Percentage and the Grade Points in the Secondary School certificate to their candidates. In such cases, the merit will be generated based on the percentage given in the marksheet. The applicants are, therefore, required to fill the 'Percentage' of marks obtained against each subject, while filling up the application form. In case an applicant applies with Grade Points instead of Percentage, his/her application will be liable for disqualification.

(viii) "The State Board of School Examinations (SBSE), Tamilnadu" has not awarded marks or grade points to their candidates in the Secondary level certificates for the year 2020-2021 due to the Covid-19 Pandemic and instead awarded a pass certificate to all the candidates. Therefore, the system will award a uniform 66.67% in such cases. The candidate has to select "Pass" against each subject while applying online. (ix) While preparing the merit list in case of tie among the applicants, the same would be decided on the basis of the following priority order: - "DOB (Older in age), ST trans-woman, ST female, SC trans- woman, SC female, OBC trans-woman, OBC female, EWS trans- woman, EWS female, UR transwoman, UR female, ST trans-male, ST Male, SC trans-male, SC Male, OBC transmale, OBC male, EWS trans- male, EWS male, UR trans-male, UR male. The Department would have the liberty and sole right to introduce any additional criteria in case of 'Tie' to determine the merit. The decision of the Department shall be final. (x) Applications submitted without complete data will be rejected. In case an applicant uploads wrong documents/information and unnecessary documents, his/her candidature will be rejected. (xi) Shortlisted applicants will have to submit an undertaking in the format annexed as Annexure-IX, regarding liability in case of furnishing fake/incorrect information/details in the form. (xii) Applicant should enter all the details such as name, Date of Birth, father's name and mother's name, etc., strictly as per the SSC (Class X) marksheet. (xiii) Applications with blurred/ illegible photographs/signatures will be rejected.

**9. COMMUNICATION OF SELECTION AND PROCESS OF PHYSICAL VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS:**

(i) The list of applicants shortlisted for engagement will be released by the Department on the GDS Online Engagement Portal. Upon declaration of the results, the shortlisted candidates will be informed of the result and dates of physical verification etc, through SMS on their registered mobile number as well as through email on the registered email addresses. However, in case of non-receipt of SMS/Email on the registered Mobile/Email address due to technical or any other reasons, the Department would not be responsible, and no communication in this respect will be entertained. Therefore, the applicants are advised to visit the website/Portal on a regular basis for the latest updates. (ii) Thereafter, the shortlisted candidates would be required to attend the office of the designated authority, i.e., the Divisional/Unit Head of the Division/Unit where the post is notified, for physical verification of documents and further engagement formalities within a period of 15 days from the date of shortlisting. Candidates who fail to report to the designated authority within the stipulated 15-day period will be marked as 'Non-turned up' by the system/portal. Consequently, the system will block further document verification for these candidates, and their candidature will be automatically cancelled. The ENGAGING AUTHORITY will conduct the physical verification of documents for all the shortlisted GDS candidates. If no discrepancy is found and the documents are found to match the originals, the verification will be deemed successful, and a system-generated 'Offer of provisional engagement' will be issued immediately. (viii) To sum up, the candidature of the candidates shortlisted in any list will be cancelled in the following situations, and the Department will issue supplementary lists against the shortlisted candidates who: (a) fail to turn up before the designated authority (i.e., the Divisional Head/Unit Head) for document verification within the stipulated time for verification of documents. (b) whose verification of documents remains unsuccessful. (c) who fail to complete the joining formalities within the stipulated period, (d) Non-submission of the caste certificate in the prescribed format within the extended period (e) who are not willing to join or have resigned after joining or failed to join due to any reason within a period of 30 days from the offer of provisional engagement. (ix) Shortlisted candidates in supplementary lists will have to undergo the same process for verification of documents/pre-engagement formalities as discussed in the foregoing paragraphs. The process of engagement will be closed, and no further list of shortlisted candidates will be issued after 30.06.2026. Further, during any stage of the recruitment or even thereafter, if it is found that any information about the candidate is false/incorrect or if the candidate has suppressed any relevant information or the candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria for the post, his/her candidature will be rejected forthwith. 9) Crucial date for claim of SC/ ST/ OBC/ EWS/EBC status or any other benefit viz. fee concession, reservation, age-relaxation, etc., where not specified otherwise, will be the closing date for submission of ONLINE applications against this CEN. 10) All the candidates seeking reservation/relaxation benefits applicable to SC/ST/OBCNCL/ EWS/PwBD/ExSM/CCAA must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation/relaxation as per eligibility prescribed in the Rules/CEN. They should be in possession of all the requisite certificates in the prescribed format in support of their claim as stipulated in the Rules and CEN. 11) **Medical Fitness:** Candidates must ensure that they fulfil the prescribed medical standards for the post(s) they are opting for. This must be completed before final submission of application for a particular CEN. This will facilitate a smoother process at different stages of recruitment for the candidates themselves. Details filled in 'Create an Account' form (including Email ID and mobile number) and chosen RRB/Railway Zone cannot be changed. 20) After 14.03.2026, RRBs shall not entertain any representation for modification of the information furnished in the application. 21) Candidates are advised, in their own interest, to submit their ONLINE application well before the closing date for submission of application and to avoid any last-minute rush. This precaution is recommended due to the possibility of heavy internet or website traffic during the final days. **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS- EXAMINATION PROCESSES:**

1) Stages of Exam: The exam shall be a single stage Computer Based Test (CBT). Railway Administration however reserves the right to conduct the CBT in either single or multi stage mode. Candidates qualifying in the CBT shall have to undergo Physical Efficiency Test (PET). It will be followed by Document Verification and Medical Examination. 2) **Call Letters:** Candidates will have to download the City and Date Intimations, e-Call Letters and Travel Authority (wherever applicable) from the links provided on the official websites of RRBs/RRCs. 3) **Short Listing for PET:** Railway/RRC wise short listing of candidates for PET shall be done at the rate of three times of the vacancies (may increase or decrease as per the requirement of Railway Administration). The short listing for PET will be based on the merit of the candidates in the CBT. Normalisation of marks will be done for CBTs held in multiple shifts. 4) Shortlisting of candidates for DV and Medical Examination shall be done Railway/RRC wise at the rate of 1:1 of the vacancies for that Railway/RRC, which shall be based on their merit in CBT and qualification in PET. The shortlisted candidates for DV shall be informed through official RRC websites as well as via SMS and email (to their registered mobile number and email ID) to download their Ecall letters for appearing in DV. 5) Negative Marking: There will be negative marking (@1/3rd mark for every wrong answer) in CBTs. 6) Calling of candidates more than number of vacancies: Candidates more than the prescribed number of vacancies may be called for PET and/or the subsequent stages. This is to take care of candidates not turning up and similar exigencies in the recruitment process. Only e-call letter will be allowed inside the test centre. Candidate should not carry any pen/Pencil inside the Test Centre. Pen will be provided to the candidates during the exam. Candidates are advised not to apply Henna on their hands/feet as this obstructs the capture of Biometrics. 9) Cloak room arrangement for safe-keeping of belongings may not be available at the exam venues. Therefore, candidates are advised not to bring any valuables/banned items including mobile phones etc. to the examination venue.

**DETAILED CENTRALISED EMPLOYMENT NOTICE (CEN)**

**1.0. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:** 1.1. Admission to all stages of recruitment process shall be purely provisional, subject to the candidates satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. 1.2. Before applying for the post(s) against this notification, candidates should satisfy themselves that they fulfil all the eligibility norms including age, educational qualifications and medical standards. Candidates should ensure that they have the requisite educational qualification from recognized Board/University/Institute as on the CLOSING DATE for submission of application for this CEN. Those awaiting results of the final examination for the prescribed qualification are not eligible and hence should not apply. 1.3. Candidates who submit more than one application for the post(s) against this CEN will be summarily rejected and will be debarred from all future examinations of RRBs and Railway Recruitment Cell (RRCs). Similarly, applications of candidates who are attempting to submit multiple applications with minor changes of information and/or facts to more than one RRB/Railway Zone and/or multiple applications to the same RRB/ Railway Zone will be summarily rejected and such candidates will also be debarred from all future examinations of RRB and RRC. 1.4. Candidates who have been debarred by any RRB/RRC either for life or for a specified period which is not yet completed should NOT apply for this notification. Their candidature will be rejected during any stage of recruitment as and when detected. 1.5. Candidates who have been

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dismissed from service by the Government of India / State Government / PSU / any other government organization are not eligible and should not apply. 1.6. Candidate should enter their name, father name, mother name and Date of birth as recorded in SSC/SSLC/Matriculation/10th class exam certificate or an equivalent certificate only, in on-line application during creation of an account. Note: However, candidates having only ITI /NAC qualification can enter these details (name, father name, mother name and Date of birth) as per the ITI/NAC certificate. However, all other details should match with SSC/SSLC/Matriculation/10th class or equivalent certificate and date of such change should be prior to the date of submission of online application. (b) Gazette Notification or any other legal document as applicable along with any one valid photo ID with the changed name, for such cases, should be submitted at the time of CBT/Document Verification (DV). 1.7 Candidates must ensure that they upload a live image of themselves, as per the instructions given in Para 16.4 and their own in running handwriting signature, in accordance with the standard specifications mentioned in Para 16.5.1. Applications with blurred, illegible, or nonstandard photographs and/or signatures are liable to be rejected at any stage of the recruitment process. Signatures of the candidates on all the documents should be uniform and identical at all stages of recruitment process and in running handwriting. NO CAPITAL/BLOCK/DISJOINTED LETTERS, SIGNATURE IS ACCEPTABLE. 1.8. Dates of CBT/PET/DV will also be published on the websites of participating RRBs/RRCs. Thereafter, E-Call letters for the CBT/PET/DV should be downloaded ONLY from official websites of the RRBs/RRCs concerned as per listed at Para 24.0 (A & B). No call letter will be sent by post. The CBT/PET/DV center, date and shift indicated in the E-call letter shall be final, and no request for change of date/time/place will be entertained. RRBs/RRCs reserve the right to introduce additional CBTs and/or PET, etc., additional DV etc. without assigning any reason. 1.9. Vacancies indicated in the CEN are provisional and may increase or decrease or even may become NIL in total or in specific communities/posts/units at a later stage depending upon the actual needs of the Railway Administration. Also, additional posts if required by the railway(s) may also be included at later stage. 1.10. The Railway Administration also reserves the right to cancel the notified vacancies at its discretion and such decision will be final and binding on all. In the event of such cancellation, the examination fee paid by the candidates will not be refunded except for candidates who have attended the CBT (Refer to para 7.0 for the amount of refund). 1.11. The mere issuance of an E-call letter does NOT imply that the candidature of the candidate has been accepted for the subsequent stages of the recruitment process by the RRB. At the time of examination, the appropriateness, authenticity & genuineness of their Photograph & Signature will be verified along with the other required credentials of the candidate before allowing them to take the exam. Credentials of the candidates will be verified along with authenticity of their submitted information at subsequent recruitment stages. 1.12. RRCs conduct verification of eligibility conditions (with reference to the original documents) only after the candidates have qualified in all the stages of examination and are provisionally shortlisted for Document Verification. At the time of Document Verification, the RRC will verify the details provided in the online application against the original supporting documents submitted by the candidates. Any discrepancy between the information declared in the application and the supporting documents OR failure to meet the eligibility criteria (such as educational qualification, age, caste/category, medical standards etc), will result in the rejection of the candidature. Furthermore, if at any stage of recruitment or afterward, it is discovered that the candidate has provided false information or suppressed material facts, their candidature or appointment will be cancelled immediately, and if appointed, such candidates will be removed from service summarily and further, such candidates will also be debarred from all future examinations of RRB and RRC for life time. 1.13. Preference for Post(s) and/or Railway(s)/Unit(s): The options from the candidates for various posts for which they are eligible in the opted Railway, shall be taken during submission of ONLINE applications. On completion of all stages of recruitment process, RRCs shall allot post & Railway/Unit as per the option of the eligible candidates ONLY subject to merit, medical standard and vacancy position. Once candidates have been empaneled as per their merit/choice, they will forfeit the right to be considered for any other post/category. Candidates with partial option will be considered only for the specific categories opted by them. In case, no option is given for certain posts, it would be considered as their unwillingness for the same. Right to Appointment: Selection by RRB/RRC does not confer upon the candidates any right of appointment in the Railways. The function of the RRB/RRC is to recommend names of suitable candidates to the concerned authorities of the Zonal Railway who in turn issue the offer of appointment letter subject to availability of vacancies and satisfying all eligibility criteria including character and antecedents. The allotment of category/post/Railway will be based on merit, post preference, medical fitness and vacancy availability on the date of panel preparation. After the category/post/Railway is allotted by RRB, candidates forfeit the right to be considered for any other post/category. 1.15. Posting: Ordinarily, a Railway servant shall be employed throughout service on the Railway or Railway establishment in which he/she is posted on first appointment and shall have no claim as a right for transfer to another Railway or another establishment. However, a Competent Authority can transfer the Railway servant to any other department or Railway establishment, including a project in or out of India, in the exigencies of service. No request for transfer to other Railway would be registered till the newly appointed candidate completes at least 5 to 10 years of service. Candidates are thus advised to choose their Railway with due care and consideration. 1.16. Selected candidates will have to undergo training, wherever prescribed and during training period only stipend will be paid as applicable. 1.17. Selected candidates who are finally appointed are liable for active service in Railway Engineers' Unit of Territorial Army. 1.18. Selected candidates will have to execute Security and/or indemnity bond wherever necessary at the time of joining in Railways. 1.19. RRBs/RRCs reserves the right to cancel / modify the results in case of any inadvertent error / typographical mistake found in the selection process of RRBs/RRCs, at any stage of recruitment process including post empanelment /also after appointment of candidate to Railways. Further, RRBs/RRCs reserves the right to delist such candidates from selection panel & cancel their appointment from Railways and if already appointed, he/she will be liable to be removed from Railway service. 1.20. Free Train Travel Facility: Free Sleeper Class Railway Pass admissible to SC & ST candidates only (on request), will be provided with their e-call letter for various stages of selection viz., CBT/ PET/ DV/ Medical Examination (as applicable) as per details and valid caste certificate furnished in their ONLINE application. While booking train reservation and travelling, the original SC & ST community certificate must be shown to authorized Railway staff concerned, for verification of genuineness of the candidate. Any misuse of this free travel facility, shall lead to rejection of candidature at any stage of the selection process including debarment for future examinations. 1.21. RRBs/RRCs reserve the right to change / modify / add / delete any of the terms & conditions of recruitment under the CEN as necessitated and applicable at any stage. 1.22. RRBs may share, with the consent of the candidates, their

scores (marks) obtained in this recruitment with other Ministries/ Departments/ Public Sector Undertakings (PSU) and Private organizations, for their recruitment. Candidates should indicate their consent / refusal for this in their ONLINE application. 2.0. VACANCIES: 2.0. The Post Parameters (Minimum/Maximum age, Qualification, Medical Standard and Suitability of the post for PwBD etc.) of various posts included in the CEN are at Annexure-A. 2.1. The Railway and post wise vacancies for all the notified posts including reservation of vacancies for SC, ST, OBC-NCL, EWS, Ex-SM, CCAA and PwBD are at Annexure-B. 2.2. The candidates are advised to read Chapter 5 of Indian Railway Medical Manual (IRMM) Vol-I which can be accessed at [www.indianrailways.gov.in](http://www.indianrailways.gov.in). Candidates must ensure that they medically fit and eligible as per prescribed medical standards for the posts opted for by them.

B. Candidates who have undergone Lasik surgery or any other surgery procedure to correct refractory error are not eligible for the post having Medical Standards A-2 & A-3 in this CEN. Candidates have to submit declaration in Annexure-VII during DV. C. F. Candidates are advised to ensure that they are eligible as per the medical standards for the post(s) opted by them. In case of failure of the candidate to pass the prescribed medical fitness for the opted posts, he/she will not be considered for empanelment for that post and alternate appointment shall not be provided. G. If a candidate fails to acquire the required medical standards for the post(s) during his initial medical examination, he/she may be offered one last and final opportunity to prefer Medical Appeal on payment of prescribed charges, with laid down conditions. **a. Blindness:** i. Total absence of sight; OR ii. Visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible correction; OR iii. Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 10 degree. **OR b. Low Vision:** i. Visual acuity not exceeding 6/18 or less than 20/60 upto 3/60 or upto 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible corrections; OR ii. Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 40 degree up to 10 degree. **B. Hearing Impaired (HI):** a.
