1. Applications are invited from unmarried male Candidates who have passed 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (hereinafter referred to as PCM) subjects and appeared in JEE (Mains) 2025 examination and fulfill the eligibility conditions prescribed in the subsequent paragraphs, for the grant of Permanent Commission in the Army for Technical Entry Scheme (TES-55). **2. Eligibility. 2.1. Nationality.** A candidate must be an unmarried male and must either be:- 2.1.1. A citizen of India. Provided that a candidate belonging to categories 2.1.2, 2.1.3 above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by Govt of India. Certificate of eligibility will, however, not be necessary in the case of candidates who are Gorkha subjects of Nepal. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to the examination provisionally, subject to, the necessary certificate being given to him by the Govt; before declaration of result by SSB/joining training. **Note 1.** Candidates must undertake not to marry until they complete their full training. A candidate, who marries subsequent to the date of his application, though successful, will not be selected for training. A candidate who marries during training shall be discharged and will be liable to refund all expenditure incurred on him by the government during training. (Ref para 6 for applicable rates of recovery). **2.2. Age Limit.** A candidate must not be below 16½ years and above 19½ years on the first day of the month in which the course is due to commence on 01 Jul 2026. Candidates who produce 10th or 12th standard mark sheet/ certificate evidencing having studied the local language will not be required to undergo the language test. **F. Total duration of examination will be 60 minutes. • All eligible applicants who have paid the examination fee will receive the intimation from BFSI Sector Skill Council of India (BFSI SSC) with an online examination link, login credential on day before the date of the examination. Failure to register for the written test will result in the candidate being disqualified from further participation in the selection process. Information regarding the written test, including the date, centre, pattern of test, will be provided on the Bank's website.
